The MUST Care Clinic Opens This Fall

WHEN YOU'RE SICK, STRUGGLING, OR SCARED,
WHERE DO YOU TURN? FOR SO MANY IN OUR
COMMUNITY, THE ANSWER HAS BEEN "NOWHERE."

NO INSURANCE. NO DOCTOR. NO HELP.

That's why MUST Ministries is opening the MUST Care Clinic this fall — a place where health and hope go hand in hand. In partnership with Eastchester Family Services as the clinic's medical services provider, the MUST Care Clinic will offer comprehensive physical and behavioral healthcare to anyone in need.

"At MUST Ministries, we believe everyone should be treated with dignity and respect, and that includes being able to access the care they need to heal," said MUST President and CEO Dr. Ike Reighard. "At the MUST Care Clinic, children will be given the shots they need for school. Families will be able to access mental healthcare services to heal from past traumas. Debilitating diseases will be uncovered from preventative care, perhaps saving lives. This is more than a clinic. It's a lifeline."

The MUST Care Clinic will be open Monday through Wednesday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., and will be available to patients of all ages. Charges for services will be based on a sliding scale and determined by the patient's ability to pay.

When school is out, so are school meals — and for thousands of children in our community, that means no lunch at home. That's why the MUST Ministries Summer Lunch program is so vital.

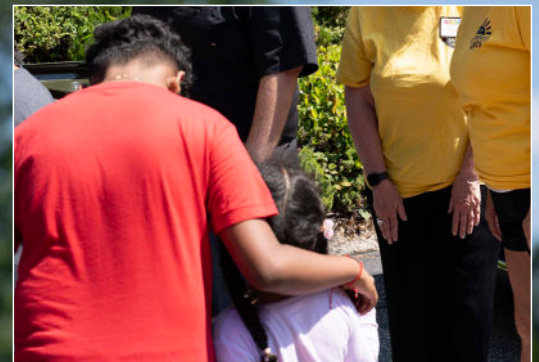

With 64 delivery routes and a dedicated team of staff and volunteers, our community worked tirelessly all summer to keep kids fed and provided **538,230 meals.**
